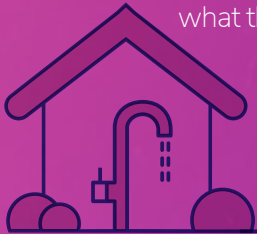
As a business in England, you no longer need to suffer in silence if you believe you could enjoy a better service with a different water supplier.

Up until April 2017,

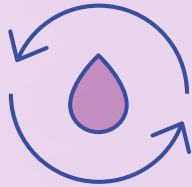
companies had to make do with what they were given but since

The first step you need to take is working out your water usage,

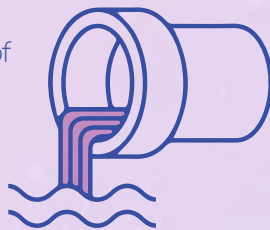
looking at your bills to find out just how much water you use and how much you pay for it.

but don't forget that you can talk to your current supplier to see if they can improve the contract you're already on before you switch.

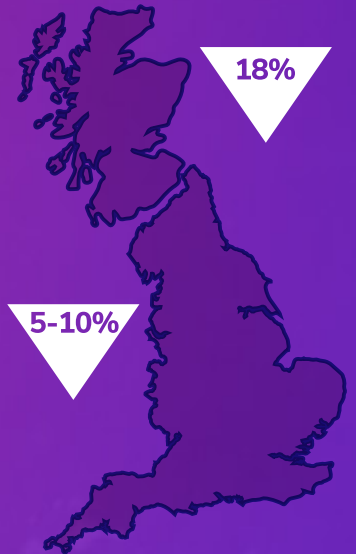


There are all sorts of benefits associated with switching, but the main reason you may likely decide to move supplier is realising

You may also find that you enjoy better service levels, including improved customer services, more accurate billing and more timely responses to enquiries.

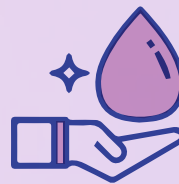

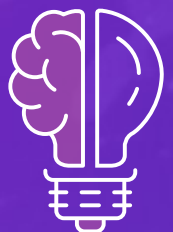
In order to be eligible to switch,
